
How To Request an Absentee Ballot

To request an absentee ballot, log on to <u>https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/</u> and follow the steps below:

Registering to Vote

If you are not yet registered to vote, you will need to do so before requesting an absentee ballot. To register (or to check if you have registered), click on the "Register To Vote" option and follow the directions.



To request an absentee ballot you can select the "Vote Absentee" option.
